

BYLAWS

Article I

Secretary/Treasurer

(a) It shall be the duty of the Secretary/Treasurer to keep the Constitution and Bylaws of the Club and have the same at every meeting.

(b) Secretary/Treasurer shall cause all amendments, changes and additions to be noted thereon and shall permit the same to be consulted by members upon request.

ARTICLE II

Membership

(a) Applications for Full Membership must include a copy of a valid operator's license.

(b) Each applicant must express a willingness to abide by the Constitution and Bylaws and other rules promulgated by the Club.

(c) Membership shall become active upon payment of annual dues.

(d) Be it resolved that any active Full Member of the CARS Club that, unfortunately, becomes a "Silent Key" shall remain on the roster of the Club for as long as the Club remains in existence.

(e) Be it resolved that any Club Meeting when there are visitors present that all Members and guest are to stand and introduce themselves by name and call sign.

ARTICLE III

Dues

(a) Regular dues shall be \$12 per year for both Full Members and Associate Members.

(b) Student Members shall pay only \$5 per year. A student is defined as any person under the age of 18 attending school.

ARTICLE IV

Meetings

(a) Regular meetings shall be held on the first Thursday of each calendar month at such time and place as the President shall designate.

(b) Special meetings may be called by the President upon request of any five Club Members.

(c) Members shall be notified of special meetings and the business to be transacted by the monthly Club Newsletter or by the Telephone Committee.

ARTICLE V

Quorum

(a) For the purpose of conducting normal Club business, at least five Full Members shall constitute a quorum.

(b) Fifty-one percent of the quorum vote is required to:
(1) Amend the Club Constitution and Bylaws, (2) Remove a Member from elected office, (3) Approve club expenditures in excess of \$100, (4) Set dues and other assessments, and (5) Revoke membership.

ARTICLE VI

Petty Cash

(a) The Secretary/Treasurer shall be provided with a petty cash fund maintained at a level of five dollars.

ARTICLE VII

Committees

(a) The Club President shall appoint special committee chairpersons as needed, especially in the areas pertaining to Emergency Coordinator, the Club Net and Education.

The members of the CARS Amateur Radio Club voted and passed a resolution to be added to the Bylaws of the Club.
